Over the last couple of years we have developed a connection with a school in a contrasting location. The school is called **Dean Hole Church Of England Primary** and is based in the village of **Dean Hole in Newark, Nottinghamshire**.

We will be visiting the school on **Wednesday 20th June**. On this day your child will need to be in school for **7.30am**. We will leave school to travel to Kings Cross station at **7.45am** on the circle line. We will then travel by train from **Kings Cross leaving at 8.30am, arriving at Newark Northgate at 9.45am**. We will travel from the station to the school by coach, this will also be used for various activities during the day.

The children from Dean Hole visited Year 5 on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> June so they have started to develop some positive friendships. Now our children are looking forward to meeting them in Newark

We will use the school as our base. During the day we will tour the village and take part in some exciting activities arranged by the school. Also as long as the weather stays fine, there will be an opportunity to play in their spacious green playground overlooked by cows and sheep. Lunch will be provided.

Your child will need a small rucksack, a snack and a drink for the train. They will **not** need any money. We have a return train booked for **3.56pm** which should get us into **Kings Cross at 5.53pm**. We should **return to school by about 6.40 pm**. I know the children will have a very memorable day. If there is anything you need to ask please speak to me in school.

We ask parents and carers to give a voluntary contribution to help support this educational visit. We suggest £5 as the train fare and cost to the school is over £600.
