Dear Parents and Carers,

To complete our Romans topic in Year 4, we will be going to All Hallows by the Tower to take part in 'Ultima Britannia: Life on a Roman Frontier' on **Thursday the 23rd of November**. This is a theatre production and workshop that allows the children to experience elements of Roman Britain first hand – including a brilliantly preserved piece of genuine Roman pavement!
