Focus: Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See

Staff Name: Nosheen & Cristal

Targets

Personal Social and Emotional: Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys.

Physical Development: Makes connection between their movements and the marks they make.

Communication and Language: Enjoys rhymes and demonstrates listening by trying to join in with actions or vocalisations.

Home learning activities

Activity 1; Making binoculars for Brown bear

This activity is a great way to develop your child's imagination skills as well as their language.

To make your very own binoculars you will need toilet tubes your baby and toddler could decorate the tubes by painting, making marks using pens, crayons, pencils. You will need tape the two tubes together and tape string to each side of the tube.

Your child will have fun looking through the binoculars as they walk around the house as they are looking through the binoculars talk to them "what they could see"

Why not take the binoculars and a teddy to a local park as your child explores looking through the binoculars again talks to them about what they see. Can your child see a dog, bird or a duck at the park? What colour are the animals? Why not give teddy a turn in looking through the binoculars what does teddy see?

Dance and do the actions to the Teddy bear song. Can your baby or toddler turn around and jump up and down? Can your baby or toddler touch their toes? Why not invite your teddy friend to join in to?

Activity 3: Playing hide and seek with Brown Bear

You could hide it under the blanket or cloth Ask your child "Where's the teddy gone?" Shrug your shoulders and show them your open palms. Then lift the cloth to reveal the teddy saying "ta da" Smile as you do this.

Does your baby smile? Do they giggle? Do they clap?
