Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sure that many of you will have heard the Prime Minister's announcement last night that schools might start to re-open from the 1st June. If they do re open then it would be just Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 children to begin with.

The information you have is exactly the same as the information that Headteachers across the country have. We don't know if we are expecting children to come back in small groups (to make social distancing easier) or in full classes or if they are expected to be in school for a couple of days or for full weeks. I am expecting some guidance on this to be published over the next couple of days.

Once I have more information and am able to put a plan together whereby our children and staff can come into school in a safe manner, I will let you know. In the meantime, we will continue to run in the same way we have for the last few weeks.

Thank you for your patience on this, while we get clarity on the situation.
